TOOLS AND SUPPLIES REQUIRED

Phillips screwdriver #2
Tape measure
Clean cloth or paper towel

INSTALLATION

- -Ensure the vehicle is clean and completely dry before installation.
- -Ensure all traces of wax, grease, silicone and any other contaminants are removed from vehicle surface where the accessory is to be installed.
- -Use of the correct screwdriver will facilitate a trouble free installation. Do not attempt to use #1 or smaller Phillips screwdriver or any type of powered screwdriver.

CARE

-Hand clean the protector using a mild soap and water solution or plastic cleaner only.


Avoid automatic car-wash equipment where a brush and/or soft cloth come in contact with the hood protector. Touch-less style automatic carwash equipment is less likely to harm the air protector.

SERVICE

-Periodically check to confirm the protector is securely attached to the hood.

WARNINGS


-Do not pull or push on the protector when opening or closing the hood.




- 1. Be sure that the hood is clean and dry.
- 2. Install the five (5) bumpons as shown.

Attention: The bumpons must be installed on the hood, not on the deflector! If the bumpons are installed on the deflector, they may wear through the paint. Note: Locate the center of the hood using a tape measure and place the bumpons as shown in the illustration.

Looking at underside of the hood Anti-abrasion Pad Locations




3. Open the hood of the vehicle. Peel and fold anti-abrasion film pads in half over the edge of the hood, in the four (4) locations shown.





 Install Metal Brackets over the hood edge in their correct positions. Align the hole in the bottom leg of the bracket with the round hole in the hood. See Illustration


NOTE: Use the metal Bracket Guide to determine where the Metal Brackets are installed in following steps. See *Illustration*.

Metal Bracket Guide












NOTE: Engaging the center pin of the "push-type retainer" is best accomplished by placing a #2 Philips screwdriver into the recess of the center pin and pushing the pin, followed by tightening 90 degrees to fully engage the retainer into the hood. The retainer can be removed by unthreading the center pin with a Philips screwdriver, however initial installation is best done using the "push" method described above.



6. Place the deflector onto the metal brackets aligning the holes in the deflector with the holes in the metal brackets.




- 7. Place the deflector on the hood, resting on the four (4) metal brackets; align the holes in the deflector with the holes in the metal brackets. Insert a "push type retainer" through the hole in the protector, and into the bracket. Ensure the protector is well seated against the surface of the metal bracket, and push the center pin of the retainer assembly to lock it into place.
- Once the push-type retainer is seated in the metal bracket, push the center pin into place. Use a Phillips head screwdriver and seat the center pin with a sharp push.




9. Peel and fold an anti-abrasion film pad in half over the edge of the hood in alignment with the remaining holes in the deflector.





- 10. Place a clip body over the anti-abrasion film pads.
- 11. Insert a pin through the deflector into each of the clip bodies.





- 12. Insert a #6 x 5/8" screw through the 'L'-bracket and into the clip body.
- 13. Make sure all the components are well seated together; the deflector is centered on the hood, and then tighten the screws into the clips.

Clean the deflector with a mild soap and water solution or plastic cleaner only. Do not use chemicals or solvents. Periodically check to make sure the bumpons are in place and the protector is secure. Avoid using automatic car washes. Do not pull on the deflector when opening or closing the hood.
